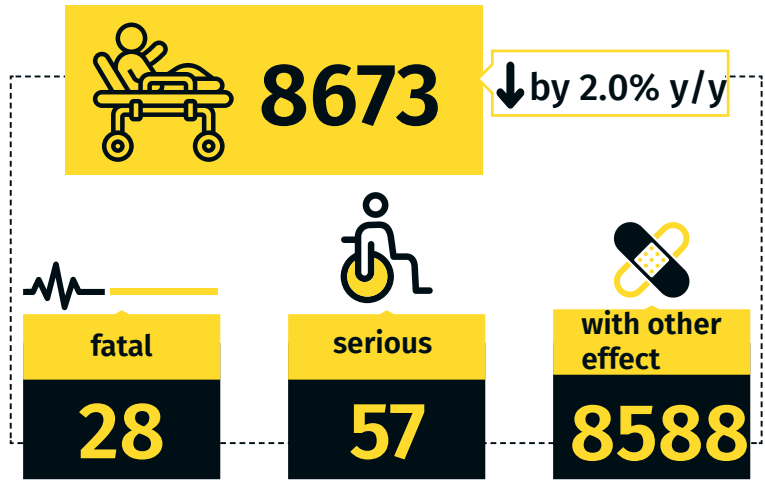


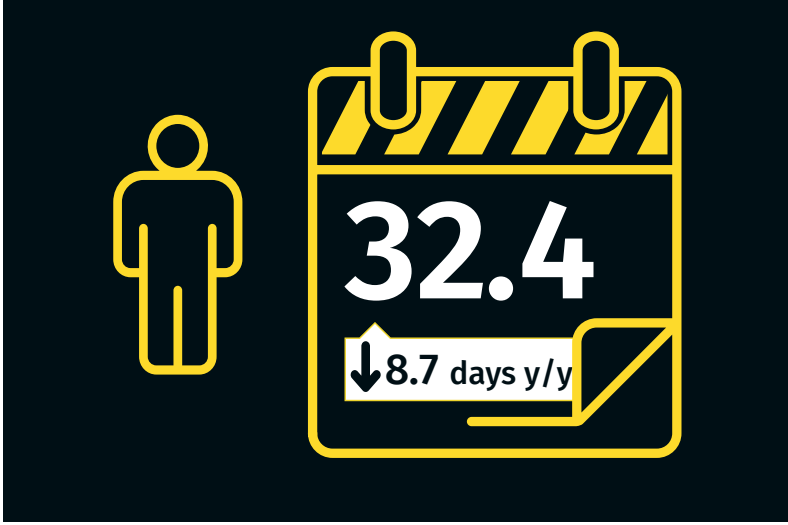

On this day, information campaigns, training sessions, and activities are organized to increase awareness of threats.

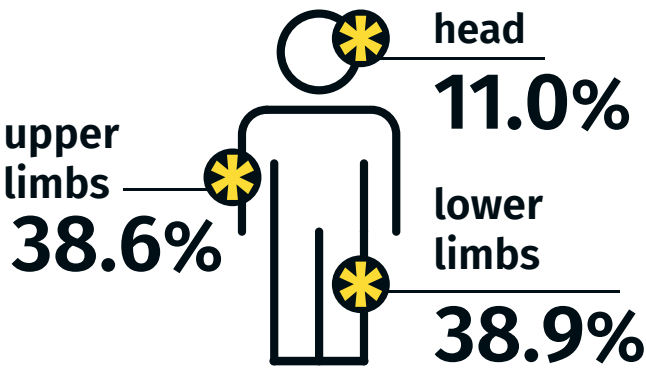
Persons injured in accidents at work



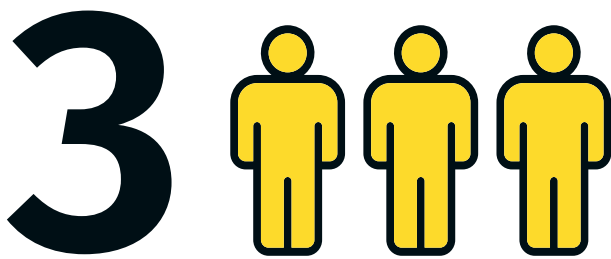
Average number of days of incapability for work per injured person^{ab}
